What's going on...?

Happy new year to you all! You might think that the Parent Council is just all about fundraising, but that's not the case, sometimes it's the skills and time from parents that are needed to help the school. Last term some parents helped to make backdrops for the Christmas Show and assisted with finding or making costumes to help make the show the absolute success it was! On two cold afternoons in November, some parents helped the children to plant 400 free trees and 600 free bulbs which the parent council had sourced so the School can look good in seasons and years to come.

The Parent Council have also worked behind the scenes to secure a grant for the School to enable them to run the Multi Sports Club. Hall Hire and Coach hire costs all add up so this grant covered this PLUS enough to also buy £500 worth of new equipment that the School can use at Gym as well as be used by the Multi Sports Club.

Since August 2017, parent council fund raising has raised over £2300 which has been used to support the school for purchasing...

Some Kindle Fire Tablets will be purchased for the School to replace the ailing elderly ipads and also a new Active Literacy Scheme which will benefit all the classes from P1 right through to P7. We'll still be using the Big Cat reading programme but this new Scheme will assist with spelling, grammar, sentence creation and loads of other things.
